

THE MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION (KUMARI SELJA): (a) and (b) Yes Sir. The Scheme of Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) launched in 2009 seeks to encourage State Government to work in partnership models with multiple stakeholders including the private sector for creation of affordable housing stock, as envisaged in the National Urban Housing and Habitat Policy 2007. The scheme has now been dovetailed with the scheme of Rajiv Awas Yojana (RAY) and is applicable to all cities covered under RAY.

Under the Affordable Housing in Partnership scheme, central assistance is envisaged at the rate of Rs. 50,000 per affordable unit or 25% of the cost of civic infrastructure (internal and external) proposed in the project, whichever is lower. Project of rental housing and dormitories for new migrants are also eligible for the above central assistance.

(c) and (d) Under Affordable Housing in Partnership Scheme, 8 projects have been sanctioned so far with a central assistance of Rs. 7.22 Crores for construction of 5776 Affordable dwelling units. As no projects have been received from the Government of Andhra Pradesh under the Scheme of Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP). Hence, no projects have been sanctioned in Andhra Pradesh.

Incidents of terrorist violence

*359. SHRI Y. S. CHOWDARY: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) the details of incidents of terrorist violence that have taken place during the last three years across the country;

(b) the details of civilians and terrorists killed in these incidents during the last three years; and

(c) the details of foreign terrorists captured and the amount spent on them for their security during the last three years?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH): (a) and (b) As per the available information, the details of Terrorist Violence/Bomb Blasts that took place in the hinterland during the last three years and the current year, the number of persons killed and status of investigation is given in Statement-I (See below).

(c) The details of foreign terrorists arrested during the last three years including current years is given in Statement-II (*See below*).

The terrorists arrested are kept in prison by the State Governments and the amount spent on prisons is not bifurcated or broken down into expenditure per prisoner. The expenditure on prisons is borne by the State Governments and the Government of India do not maintain any data on that.

2. Mirza Khan, an Afghan national having links with Al Qaida was interdicted at Purnea Railway Station by Purnea Sadar, PS on January 19, 2010.
3. Ghulam Waris, Nepali citizen, LeT/ISI operative was arrested at Katihar on March 18, 2010.
4. Irfan Ullah @ Roshan, Pak national/ISI agent was arrested near Mohali, Punjab on May 29, 2010.
5. Umer Farooq Aslam @ Monir Khan, Pak national/ISI agent was arrested from Agartala on July 04, 2010.
6. Abdullah Inqalabi, a Pak national, Divisional Commander of HMPPR (Hizb-ul-Mujahideen Pir Panjal Regiment) arrested near IIT Campus in Delhi in November 15, 2010.
7. Mohd. Adil Khan @ Suraj @ Mohd. Ali @ Ajmal @ Waleed @ Shoaib S/o Mohd. Shafiq Khan, a Pak national/Jem operative was arrested from Madhubani Bihar on November 25, 2011.
