

(c) The proposed complex will be a State-of-the-Art complex which will produce petroleum as well as petrochemical products and will meet the latest environmental norms and product specifications. It will be capable of processing local Rajasthan crude as well as imported crude.

(d) The estimated capital investment is Rs. 37,230 crore.

(e) The refinery is expected to be completed in four years.

Performance and financial audit of KG-D6 oil fields

3237. SHRI K.N. BALAGOPAL: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the performance and financial audit is conducted for oil fields in the KG-D6;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) if not, the reason therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRIMATI PANABAKA LAKSHMI): (a) to (c) The Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) has carried out performance audit of Block KG-DWN-98/3 for two financial years *i.e.* 2006-07 & 2007-08 along-with three more blocks namely Panna-Mukta, Mid & South Tapti and RJ-ON-90/1. The final report on the Performance Audit of Hydrocarbons Production Sharing Contracts (PSCs) has been tabled in the Parliament by CAG on 08.09.2011. The report of the CAG has been referred to Public Accounts Committee (PAC) and the same is under consideration of the PAC.

The Audit of Block KG-DWN-98/3 for the period from 2008-09 to 2011-12 is under progress in accordance with the provisions laid down in the Production Sharing Contract by CAG.

Inspection of LPG distributorship sites by OMCs

(a) whether the Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) undertake regular surprise inspection at distributor's premises, conduct refill audit and surprise checks at customer's premises;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the details of LPG distributors found guilty of malpractices during the last three years; and

(d) the punitive action taken against the guilty distributors as per the provisions of Marketing Discipline Guidelines?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRIMATI PANABAKA LAKSHMI): (a) to (d) Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) undertake regular inspections at LPG godowns as well as showrooms of LPG distributorships and conduct refill audits. In addition, customer calls are also made by OMCs officers at customers premises to get feedback on quality of service and complaints.
